Feb 2-3 Setsubun

Setsubun literally translates to “division of seasons” (the last day of winter). Scatter roasted soy beans on Setsubun to drive away evil spirits and bring good luck.

- Many events and rituals are held at shrines and temples such as Yoshida Shrine, Rozan-ji Temple, Mibudera Temple, Kitano Tenmangu Shrine, Yasaka Shrine, Heian Shrine, etc.
