Gion Matsuri Events

Jul 10 Omukae Chochin (welcoming Lanterns)
Parade of 300 people in costume. Some groups with music or dance etc. and lanterns ● Yasaka Shrine 16:30 → Kyoto City Hall 17:30 /18:30 → Teramachi St. to Shijo 18:50 → Yasaka Shrine 19:30~20:30

Jul 10 Mikoshi Arai Purification
The rites of cleaning the Sacred Carriages with the water from the Kamo River ● Shijo Bridge 20:00

Jul 10-14 Hoko and Yama Construction
23 floats of Former Festival are assembled on the streets

Jul 12-13 Hoko and Yama Trial Pulling
People practice pulling the floats on the street ● 14:00- 15:30

Jul 14-16 Yoiyama
After dark, people go to see the lit-up Yama and Hoko (floats) and enjoy festival music. Countless stalls are set up along Shijo St., Karasuma St, Muromachi St. Shinmachi St., etc.

Jul 17 Early Festival Yamahoko-Junko (Grand Parade)
The procession of 23 floats along the main streets of Kyoto

Procession of the Sacred Carriages
The three sacred carriages carried from Yasaka Shrine to Otabisho(Shijo Teramachi) ● Yasaka Shrine 18:00 → Shijo Yamatooji 18:20 → Kawaramachi Sanjo 20:20~21:35 → Shijo Otabisho 21:00~22:45

11 floats of Latter Festival are assemble on the streets
