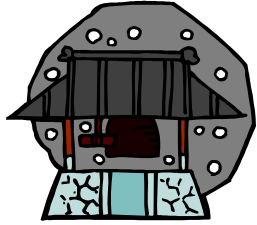


# JOYA NO KANE

Kiyomizu Temple 清水寺 Tel: 075-551-1234	"Gojozaka 五条坂" or "Kiyomizu-michi 清水道" bus stop	On 25th, numbered tickets will be distributed on a first-come, first-served basis from 9:00. Then on 31st, after monks ring the bell at 23:30, you can ring in pairs.
Kenninji Temple 建仁寺 Tel: 075-561-6363	"Higashiyama 東山安井" or "Gion 祇園" bus stop	At 22:00, 108 numbered tickets will be distributed on a first-come, first-served basis. From 23:45, people start to ring the bell.
Kodaiji Temple 高台寺 Tel: 075-561-9966	"Higashiyama Yasui 東山安井" bus stop	At 22:00, 108 numbered tickets will be distributed on a first-come, first-served basis. From 23:45, people start to ring the bell.
Chishakuin Temple 智積院 Tel: 075-541-5361	"Higashiyama Nanajo 東山七条" bus stop	After the fire ritual (from 23:30), monks ring the bell (23:45) then people in line can ring the bell.
Seiganji Temple 誓願寺 Tel: 075-221-0958	"Shijo Kawaramachi 四条河原町" bus stop	From 23:00 one group of 3-4 persons can ring the bell until 108 times ring.
