- Japan's oldest horseback archery ritual ● 13:00 ● Kamigamo Shrine



#### Oct 20 Saigu Procession

- A procession of imperial princess in gorgeous Heian costumes ● 12:00~ ● Nonomiya Shrine in Arashiyama

#### Oct 22 Jidai Matsuri Festival

- Spectacular Procession of 2,000 people in historical costume ● 12:00 Start at Kyoto Imperial palace ● 14:30 Arrive at Heian Jingu Shrine



#### Oct 22 Kurama Fire Festival

- A parade with hundreds of people bearing flaming torches ● 18:00-24:00 ● Yuki Shrine
