#### Feb 2 - 4 Setsubun

Setsubun literally translates to "division of seasons" (the last day of winter). Roasted soybeans are scattered during this time to drive away evil spirits and bring good luck.

Many events and rituals are held at shrines and temples such as Yoshida Shrine, Rozan-ji Temple, Mibudera Temple, Kitano Tenmangu Shrine, Yasaka-jinja Shrine, Heian-jingu Shrine, etc.

Radish is cooked and served to pray for good health and happiness throughout the year.

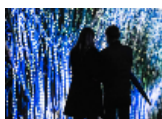
